## From the Principal's Desk

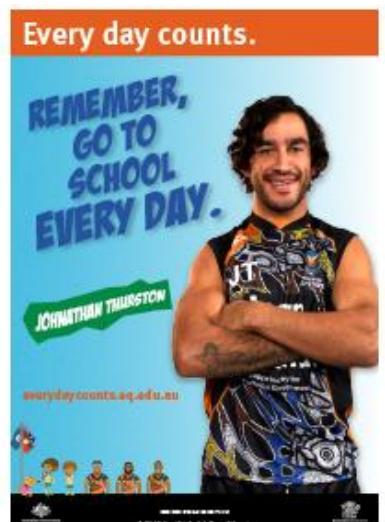


### Easter Hat Parade-

At Harristown, our approach to NAPLAN preparation is simple. Each teacher from Prep to Year 6 is committed to preparing their students for success by carefully planning and delivering the curriculum for that year level, differentiation to meet the range of learning needs in their class and closely monitoring achievement. Congratulations to our Year 3 and 5 students (and their teachers) for their terrific preparation in the lead-up to these tests.

Some NAPLAN tips for parents of students in Years 3 and 5:

- \* keep things at home relaxed (NAPLAN is just another test that students do at school)
- \* try to make sure your child gets a good sleep the night before
- \* make sure your child eats a good breakfast
- \* if your child needs to wear glasses, make sure they have them packed and that they are cleaned
- \* celebrate your child's best efforts on the day
- \* most importantly, make sure your child is in their classroom at the first bell (8:45).
